1. Korean Language Education Major

'Korean language education experts proficient in Korean'

The goal of our Korean language education major is to cultivate Korean language experts who possess outstanding Korean language skills, specialized knowledge in Korean language education, and practical abilities in the field of education.

Korean students, who are native Korean speakers, take courses in the Korean language education field that enable them to obtain a national qualification for Korean language teachers (level 2). Foreign exchange students, in addition to the Korean language education field, take courses in the Korean language immersion area, which consists of Korean language and culture, and translation, to improve their Korean language comprehension and expression abilities as well as their cross-cultural competence.

The education objectives of our Korean language education major include:

- Enhancing advanced Korean language skills
- Acquiring specialized knowledge in Korean language education
- Fostering practical and field-applicable abilities through a hands-on learning approach
- Fostering creative abilities that are required in various Korean language utilization fields.

2. Requirements to receive the MA degree

- Required credits: 36 (for foreign students)
- Average GPA: 3.0 or higher
- Pass the comprehensive exam

(It is recommended to apply for the above documents in advance, as it takes a long time to obtain them.) Online certificate issuance documents must be valid until the admission application period.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Financial Statement (\$20,000 bank statement) <p>※ Please prepare two original copies of BA Graduation Certificate, BA Transcript, and financial statement.</p>

 - ③ 1 photo
 - ④ BA original graduation certificate and transcript verified by a Korean embassy or consulate.
- ※ Please refer to the above guidelines for preparing the final education verification documents.
- ⑤ TOPIK Score Level 4 or higher
 - ⑥ A document proving financial ability (bank statement of \$20,000)
 - ⑦ Documents proving family relationship (if parent's bank statement is submitted)
 - ⑧ IGSE Admission Certificate
 - ⑨ IGSE Business Registration Certificate
 - ⑩ Receipt of tuition fee payment
- ※ Additional documents may be required depending on the country, so please check the required documents at the Korean embassy in the your country.
